PLANNING ADVICE

- Work closely with your sponsor Rotary Club, school helper and/or community organisations.
- Create goals for an event or an activity.
- Plan events or activities that are fun for participants.
- Keep it all very simple.
- Work out practical ways to advertise and promote the event or activity in plenty of time.
- Know your cause and inform students or community members.
- Establish ways of convincing participants to support your fundraising event and possibly provide an incentive.
- Include the whole school where possible.

FUNDRAISING IDEAS

School disco.

- Free dress; Loud shirt; Crazy hat or Odd socks day for a gold coin. Prizes awarded.
- Car washing.
- Busking.
- Bake sales.
- Raffles.
- Catering stall on athletics day.
- Stall at a school event e.g. open night.
- Sausage sizzle.
- Pancake day.
- Book donations and sales.
- Paint a pinkie for polio.
- Pick a stick (from sandpit) chance to win \$10.00.
- Create a line of gold coins for a cause or fill in a chalk picture.
- Get active fun event e.g. obstacle course; throw the gumboot; egg and spoon race; sack race; three legged races etc.
- Morning tea for Mother's Day.
- Talent quest competition.
- Concert for students.

OTHER PROJECT IDEAS

- Create a native garden at school.
- Collect items to donate e.g. Easter eggs; blankets & pillows for the homeless etc.
- Collect non perishable food and other items to make hampers for disadvantaged families at Christmas.
- Sell poppies for Remembrance Day.
- Collect items for Donations in Kind (DIK) to be sent overseas (seek advice from DIK first).
- Operation Christmas Child collect filled shoe boxes and provide service to others.
- Visit a kindergarten and help with the young children.
- Collect stationery to distribute to groups less fortunate than yourselves.
- Visit an aged care residence and provide companionship.
- Collect second hand books and donate to DIK. Seek some advice first.
- Clean up Australia Day clean up the school.
- Say NO to Bullying support school policies in practice.
- Collect food and goods for RSPCA e.g. pet food and blankets etc. (Seek advice from RSPCA first).
