### PLANNING ADVICE

- Work closely with your sponsor Rotary Club, school helper and/or community organisations.
- Create goals for an event or an activity.

- Know your cause and inform students or community members.
- Establish ways of convincing participants to support your fundraising event and possibly provide an incentive.
- Include the whole school where possible.

Seek some advice first.</li> <li>▪ Clean up Australia Day – clean up the school.</li> <li>▪ Say NO to Bullying – support school policies in practice.</li> <li>▪ Collect food and goods for RSPCA – e.g. pet food and blankets etc. (Seek advice from RSPCA first).</li> </ul>
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
